Regulations & Policies

The SRCC will adhere as closely as possible to the recommendations put forth by Curl Canada and all government regulations.

SRCC will follow the directions and protocols as they are announced by the Government of Manitoba.

The Swan River Community Centre will work diligently to keep our community safe at all times and operational for the entire season.

LEAGUE PLAY

- No handshakes before and after game
- There shall be only 1 sweeper at a time, skips cannot sweep opposing teams rock that pass the t line
- There will be marks on the ice indicating where to stand while waiting to play
- One person designated to mark score

CLEANLINESS

- Masks are recommended
- Sanitize hands upon entry
- Rocks will be sanitized before each game
- Any player throwing practice rocks at any time will be responsible for sanitizing all rocks used
- No water provided on ice area
- Facility will be continuously cleaned

LOCKER ROOM

- Limited number of people in locker room at one time
- Preferably come ready to play
- Proper social distance practices and spacing

TRAFFIC FLOW

- Entrance through the front door, exit through the back
- Changes will be made if there is congestion prior to going on ice

LOUNGE

- Proper social distancing/practices and spacing will be in effect with tables spaced 6 feet apart

SPECTATORS

- Must sign in upon arrival to the facility and follow the protocols in place

WAIVERS

- All curlers must sign a Curl Canada waiver

REFUND POLICY

- In the event of closure during season, the balance of fees will be retained till end of June and any remaining funds would be applied to next season.
